





History of HELLA SHRINERS

Service on the Board of Governors for the past 50 years

Hella has had ten (10) members from our temple who have been elected and served on the Houston Hospital since 1976. They are Clarke Petet, William D. Pardue, H. Jim Lemmon, Ted Lyman, Jr., Alton Edwards, Harry Donald Moore, Jr., Orville E. McGuffey, Kenoth H. Flourney, Jimmie Lee Alford and Larry V. Hall. Seven (7) of these members became Emeritus Members.

Hella has had had seven (7) members from our temple who have been elected and served on the Galveston Hospital since 1973. They are John R. Wallace, George Terry, S. Earl Knox, Stanley H. Ballard, Lawrence A. Winkle, Douglas A. Lord, and Robert M “John” Rodriguez. Four (4) of these members became Emeritus Members.

In 1920, when the vote was taken to merge the hospitals, the name was changed to Shriners Children’s Texas. At that time, we had 22 hospitals and today we only have 13 hospitals. Several have been converted to Ambulatory Surgery Centers or Outpatient Clinics. Today, Shriners Children’s Texas is doing well and growing. We have two members recently from Hella who are now Emeritus Members of Shriners Children’s Texas, Jimmy L. Heisz and Robert W. Moore.

Other members of Hella Shrine have served as Associate Members over the years.



September Stated Meeting Memories



Self-CPR During a Heart Attack.

Remember - Time is of the Essence

Please take two minutes of your time and read this:

Let's say it's 7:25 pm, and you're heading home (alone, of course) after an especially tough day at work. You're really tired, agitated, and frustrated. Suddenly, you start experiencing severe chest pain. The pain continues down your arm and up to your jaw. You're about 5 miles away from the nearest hospital. Unfortunately, you don't know if you'll be able to make it there. You're trained in performing CPR, but the person who taught you didn't explain how to do it on yourself.

How do you survive a heart attack when you're alone? Since many people are alone when they suffer a heart attack and the heart's rhythm becomes incorrect, leading to weakness, there are only 10 seconds before losing consciousness. However, these victims can help themselves by coughing forcefully and repeatedly. A deep breath should be taken before each cough, and the cough must be deep and prolonged, as if trying to produce phlegm from deep within the chest. Breathe and cough (repeat this every two seconds without stopping) until help arrives or until you feel the heart beating normally again. Deep breaths bring oxygen into the lungs, and coughing movements press on the heart and maintain blood circulation. The action of pressing on the heart helps it return to its regular rhythm. This way, heart attack victims can reach the hospital.

Tell as many people as possible. You can save lives! A cardiologist says that if everyone who receives this message sends it to 10 people, we can save a life at least once. Instead of sending jokes, please... contribute by passing on this message, which can save a person's life. If this message reaches you... more than once... please don't be upset... instead, be glad that you have many friends who care about you.

Pass it on... A moment of your time won't hurt.



Suggested Blue Lodge Program

Shriners International, also commonly known as The Shriners or formerly known as the Ancient Arabic Order of the Nobles of the Mystic Shrine, (AAONMS) is a Masonic society established in 1870 and is headquartered in Tampa, Florida. Shriners International describes itself as a fraternity based on fun, fellowship, and the Masonic principles of brotherly love, relief, and truth.

In The Beginning... In 1870 a group of Masons gathered frequently for lunch in New York City. Among the regulars were Walter M. Fleming, M.D. and William J. "Billy" Florence, an actor. The group frequently talked about starting a new fraternity for Masons – one centered on fun and fellowship, more than ritual. Fleming and Florence took this idea seriously enough to do something about it.

Billy Florence had been on tour in France, and had been invited to a party given by an Arabian diplomat. The exotic style, flavors and music of the Arabian-themed party inspired him to suggest this as a theme for the new fraternity. Walter Fleming, a devoted fraternity brother, built on Florence's ideas and used his knowledge of fraternal ritual to transform the Arabian theme into the Ancient Arabic Order of the Nobles of the Mystic Shrine (A.A.O.N.M.S.).

By June 1922 the cornerstone had been laid for the first Shriners Hospitals for Children® in Shreveport, La. The first patient to be admitted in 1922 was a little girl with a clubfoot, who had learned to walk on the top of her foot rather than the sole.

In 1926 the Hella Shrine Hospital for Crippled Children in Dallas, Texas, became the Scottish Rite Children's Hospital and the oversight and support was assumed by the Scottish Rite Bodies.

Never does a Shriner stand so tall as when he stoops to help a child. Through the remarkable foresight, commitment and fundraising skills of the Shriners International (Headquarters in Tampa) nearly one million children have been treated at one of the 21 Shriners Hospitals for Children across the United States, and in Canada and Mexico.

There are 196 Temples worldwide and approximately 350k members. Shriners International is a fraternity based on fun, fellowship and the Masonic principles of brotherly love, relief and truth. We strive to continue support and provide care for our Hospitals for Children with a worldwide network, no matter the families ability to pay.

Shriners International is among the greatest Philanthropy's on the planet! Shriners Hospitals for Children has 21 health systems within the United States!

Hella Hospital Fund Raisers include (not limited to):

- Bucket Drive - Annual Collection Brigades, staff designated street locations to collect money for our hospitals (Fez on the corner, branding at its best!) Usually a two-day event. Shifts are available, any time increments from 30 min to 8 hours.
