Oriental Guide

Greetings brothers!

I was asked "why do the Shriners wear those funny hats?" The Shriners chose a Middle Eastern motif not for any religious or cultural connection, but because it was seen as "exotic" and "fun" to their founders in 1870s America. This theme was deliberately adopted to create a distinct, visually appealing identity for the group.

A "Fun" Alternative. The Shriners were founded as a playful, social counterpart to the more serious Freemasonry. The Middle Eastern theme, inspired by the mystique of the One Thousand and One Nights, gave the organization a unique and entertaining character. Founder William J. Florence attended a party in France with an "Arabian" theme. Intrigued, he took notes and later worked with Dr. Walter M. Fleming to build the Shriners' rituals and aesthetic around this concept.

The red fez, adopted as the official headwear, was a symbol of the Ottoman Empire, chosen to reinforce their "Arabian" image.

Fields Yet Unseen

It was a Thursday evening, as the sun settles over the familiar walls of Hella Shrine, I feel something that is difficult to describe. The building seems to breathe. Laughter echoes through the halls, old friends shake hands, and new nobles are welcomed as though they have always belonged. To many, it is simply a fraternity. To me, it is family. There was a time when I wondered if I would ever walk through these doors again.

My stroke came without warning. One day I was planning events, leading meetings, and looking toward the future. The next, I was learning that life could change in an instant. Recovery forced me to slow down. It taught me that strength is not measured by how much I can accomplish in a day, but by my willingness to keep taking the next step, even when it is difficult.

More than anything, my recovery reminded me that I have never walked this journey alone. As I look around Hella Shrine today, I see brothers who prayed for me, encouraged my family, stepped in when I couldn't, and reminded me that I was still part of something greater than myself. Their faithfulness brings to mind one of my favorite stories in Scripture—the Book of Ruth.

When Naomi believed her future had ended, Ruth refused to leave her side. “Where you go, I will go.” Those words are more than beautiful poetry. They are a promise of loyalty, hope, and steadfast love. Ruth could not see the harvest waiting for her in Bethlehem, but she trusted God enough to keep walking. That story has taken on a new meaning for me.

I see Hella Shrine as its own field of harvest. Every parade we march in, every fundraiser we hold, every child whose life is changed through our hospitals, and every new noble who joins our ranks is the result of seeds planted long before I arrived. Men I admire gave their time, their talents, and their hearts so that this fraternity would continue to grow. Their greatest accomplishment was never a building or a title. It was the people they invested in.

Like Boaz welcoming Ruth into his field, those men welcomed me. They taught me, corrected me, encouraged me, and trusted me with responsibilities I wasn't always sure I was ready for. Now it is my turn to do the same for those who come after me.

My stroke changed me. It changed what I can do physically, but it also changed how I see the future. I no longer measure success by attendance numbers or how full our calendar is. I measure it by whether a young father feels at home the first time he walks through our doors. Whether a new Shriner finds lifelong friends. Whether our fraternity continues to serve children and families with the same compassion that has defined us for generations. I believe our future will require change. We'll have to embrace new ideas, develop new leaders, and find new ways to tell an old story. But I also believe our foundation must never change.

Faith.

Service.

Brotherly love.

As I leave Hella Shrine after another evening with my brothers, I am reminded that Ruth's story did not end with loss. It ended with restoration, hope, and a legacy that would shape generations. Maybe that is how God works. Fields that appear empty are often preparing for harvest. Lives interrupted are often being redirected. And organizations willing to honor their past while embracing the future become stronger than they ever imagined. The future of Hella Shrine will never be built by one man. It never has been.

It will be built by all of us—ordinary people who choose faithfulness over fear, service over self, and hope over uncertainty. And when we stand together—bound by faith, strengthened by service, and carried forward by hope—there is no limit to what we can become, because we are not just building a future... we are building it together.

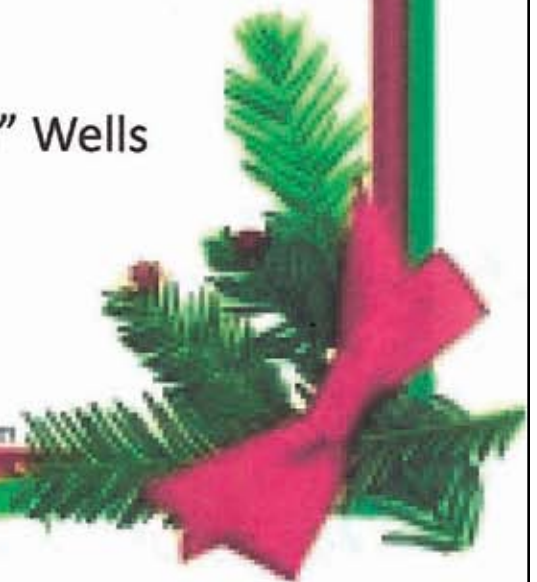

Suggested Blue Lodge Program

Shriners International, also commonly known as The Shriners or formerly known as the Ancient Arabic Order of the Nobles of the Mystic Shrine, (AAONMS) is a Masonic society established in 1870 and is headquartered in Tampa, Florida. Shriners International describes itself as a fraternity based on fun, fellowship, and the Masonic principles of brotherly love, relief, and truth.

In The Beginning... In 1870 a group of Masons gathered frequently for lunch in New York City. Among the regulars were Walter M. Fleming, M.D. and William J. "Billy" Florence, an actor. The group frequently talked about starting a new fraternity for Masons – one centered on fun and fellowship, more than ritual. Fleming and Florence took this idea seriously enough to do something about it.

Billy Florence had been on tour in France, and had been invited to a party given by an Arabian diplomat. The exotic style, flavors and music of the Arabian-themed party inspired him to suggest this as a theme for the new fraternity. Walter Fleming, a devoted fraternity brother, built on Florence's ideas and used his knowledge of fraternal ritual to transform the Arabian theme into the Ancient Arabic Order of the Nobles of the Mystic Shrine (A.A.O.N.M.S.).

By June 1922 the cornerstone had been laid for the first Shriners Hospitals for Children® in Shreveport, La. The first patient to be admitted in 1922 was a little girl with a clubfoot, who had learned to walk on the top of her foot rather than the sole.

In 1926 the Hella Shrine Hospital for Crippled Children in Dallas, Texas, became the Scottish Rite Children's Hospital and the oversight and support was assumed by the Scottish Rite Bodies.

Never does a Shriner stand so tall as when he stoops to help a child. Through the remarkable foresight, commitment and fundraising skills of the Shriners International (Headquarters in Tampa) nearly one million children have been treated at one of the 21 Shriners Hospitals for Children across the United States, and in Canada and Mexico.

There are 196 Temples worldwide and approximately 350k members. Shriners International is a fraternity based on fun, fellowship and the Masonic principles of brotherly love, relief and truth. We strive to continue support and provide care for our Hospitals for Children with a worldwide network, no matter the families ability to pay.

Shriners International is among the greatest Philanthropy's on the planet! Shriners Hospitals for Children has 21 health systems within the United States!

Hella Hospital Fund Raisers include (not limited to):

- Bucket Drive - Annual Collection Brigades, staff designated street locations to collect money for our hospitals (Fez on the corner, branding at its best!) Usually a two-day event. Shifts are available, any time increments from 30 min to 8 hours.
- Hella Classic Dirt Track Race - Usually taking place at the Greenville Super Bowl Speedway. This event usually raises 20-30k dollars for our kids. Toys and Bicycles are drawn by tickets obtained at the box office and handed out by Nobles of the Shrine. It's always a great family activity!
- Clubs and Units around the jurisdiction of Hella will conduct annual fund raisers as well, and contribute to the Hospitals, Hospital Transportation, etc.
- We raised more than 75k dollars in 2020 through these events!

TEMPLE DUES

The nobility of each temple within Shriners International sets the amount of its annual dues to offset the administrative operations incurred by the temple.

Each member is required to remit his annual temple dues before January 1st of each year to avoid delinquency.

Look around when you attend a temple meeting or event, and you will see your temple dues hard at work. Without this financial structure, your continued membership and payment of temple dues, there would be no source from which to fund temple operations.

The future of your temple and the fraternity as a whole relies on your fidelity and faithful dues remittance!

PER CAPITA TAX

A \$50.00 Per Capita Tax shall be assessed with each member's annual dues and remitted to Shriners International in order to keep our fraternity and its Headquarters financially stable, with the continued ability to provide much-needed services.

Similarly to the way each noble's dues are necessary to maintain temple operations, each noble's Per Capita Tax payment maintains the administrative function of Shriners International.

HOSPITAL ASSESSMENT

A Hospital Assessment of \$5.00 per regular member is remitted to the Imperial Treasurer each year and deposited into the endowment fund for Shriners Hospitals for Children®.

These monies are invested to support our official philanthropy.

The good work performed at our hospitals is paramount to serving mankind, consistent with the mission statement of Shriners International.

As owners of the hospital system, a spirit of generosity has led nobles to give above and beyond the hospital assessment. This generosity has allowed our hospitals to grow beyond all expectations, succeeding in their quest to help more children throughout the world!
