Oriental Guide

I want to take you back to an event that captured the hearts of millions around the world: the rescue of Jessica McClure on this very day in 1987. You may remember the story—an 18-month-old toddler who fell into an abandoned well in Midland, Texas, and was trapped 22 feet underground for 58 harrowing hours.

The world watched, prayed, and waited, as rescue crews—miners, paramedics, engineers, and volunteers—worked tirelessly around the clock to bring her to safety. It wasn't just a rescue; it was a moment when the entire world came together, driven by one shared mission: to save a child.

Now, why am I bringing this up to a bunch of Shriners?

Because at its heart, that story is not just about a rescue—it's about compassion, dedication, and specialized skill, the same core values that define Shriners International and the Shriners Children's health system.

Just as Jessica's rescuers used ingenuity and teamwork to save one child in crisis, Shriners across the world work every single day to improve the lives of children facing medical challenges—through best in class care, cutting-edge research, and unwavering emotional support.

Think about it: Jessica was stuck in a dark, narrow space, utterly dependent on strangers aboveground to lift her out.

Now imagine a child with scoliosis, severe burns, or a complex orthopedic condition—trapped not in a well, but in a body that limits their freedom. Who's there to lift them out?

We are.

Our fraternity is about more than just fellowship and fun. It's about being the hand that reaches down when no one else can—or will. It's about giving children a path to healing when the journey seems impossible. Whether it's providing life-altering surgeries, prosthetics, rehabilitation, or emotional support for families—Shriners step in where others step back.

And just like Jessica's rescuers worked together with different tools, skills, and backgrounds to achieve the impossible, our network—of donors, doctors, volunteers, and nobles—unites under a common mission: to rescue, to heal, and to give hope.

Today, Baby Jessica is a grown woman, living a quiet life, forever grateful for those who saved her. Most of the rescuers never became household names. They didn't want fame—they just wanted to help.

Shriners know that feeling well.

Every child we help may not know our names, but they carry the results of our work for the rest of their lives. That is the quiet legacy of this fraternity—a brotherhood not only of men, but of miracle workers.

So if you ever think of that little girl in the well again, as I did this morning, remember that story is still being written—every time we put on a fez, roll up our sleeves, and say, "How can I help?"

If there is any confusion floating around about the direction or future for this Shrine, let this message go out from this place and this time...our mission is too important to fail, too critical for petty disputes to derail, and too critical to accept delays. Hella Shrine is NOT in the midst of a death spiral, but rather a reclamation and recommitment for the next 200 years!

I continue to be honored to serve as your oriental guide, and I look forward to the next time we can strap on our fez together, roll up our sleeves, and ask how we can help!

Official Notice

As required by the By-Laws of the Imperial Council of our Order, Notice is hereby tendered to the membership of Hella Shrine that the regular annual session of the Temple will be held in the Hella Shrine Ballroom, 2121 Rowlett Rd., Garland, Texas, 75043, on December 18, 2025. Dinner at 6:30 pm, Stated Meeting at 7:30 pm. Ladies entertainment 7:30 pm.

At this meeting, officers for the coming year will be elected and such other business transacted as is proper and which usually comes before the annual meeting.

The Imperial Council By-Laws require every Temple to quote the following Imperial Council By-Laws.

Candidates MUST be in GOOD STANDING.

Section 325-10

“(a) The printing, publication or distribution of resolutions, letters, telegrams, tickets or other devices, by a Noble, suggesting, recommending, opposing or containing the names of proposed candidates for office in the Temple is prohibited.

(b) For any violation of (a), the Imperial Potentate may suspend any offending Noble, and he may declare the election of officers void and order a new election.

(c) At least one week prior to the Annual Meeting or any election, the Temple Recorder shall mail to each member a notice containing this section.”

Divan Line Officers Must Be Selected Wisely

We are genuinely grateful that our Temple has been favored in past years and is currently favored with sincere, honest, able and devoted leadership through its elected Officers. However, external vigilance must be wisely and thoughtfully exercised by the voting membership in order to perpetuate a high caliber of leadership!

Every Noble is a good Noble... but it does not necessarily follow that every Noble is fitted to meet the rigorous demands imposed upon Divan Officers and Potentates.

So let us be fair, honest and wise in the all important matter of electing to Office only men who are eminently qualified for the job. We all know that with honor comes responsibility. And while there is high honor associated with a Divan Office, the ensuing responsibilities entail a lot of time consuming, energy consuming, WORK!

So That You May Know

The Nobility of Hella Temple will elect its Officers at the **Annual Meeting, December 18, 2025.**

We believe some of the points established in this article will be very helpful to you in selecting your Officers for Hella Temple. Our desire to be of help to our Temple has prompted us to present it to you for your consideration

The Elected Divan

A Noble can be a good fellow, a hard worker and a loyal Shriner... and yet lack the basic qualifications which make a good Potentate. Unless a Noble is fully qualified for the job, it is unfair both to himself and to his Temple in seeking the Office or allowing his fellow Nobles to support and promote his candidacy

Each Shrine Temple needs and requires able leadership. The normal starting point of that leadership is demonstrated by what the candidate has done previously serving in the elected and appointed officers of the Temple. The following Check List may prove helpful in evaluating potential candidates for the vacant offices. However, no thinking man would be so naive or presumptuous as to believe that any one Noble could possibly embody all of the virtues, talents and qualifications which are set forth in this Check List. Nevertheless the List has practical value... for self evaluation by the Noble whose ultimate aspiration is the Office of Illustrious Potentate and for evaluation of potential candidates by the voting members.

Qualifications for Hella Temple Office.

The candidates should have demonstrated:

- Leadership
- Executive Ability
- Business Sense
- Community Standing and Influence
- Well Poised
- Good Health
- Diplomacy
- Stage Presence
- Competent Organizer and Promoter
- Possess Social Graces
- Financially Secure
- Energy and Vitality
- Free to devote ample time
- Capable of building Public Relations
- Good Habits and Moral Character
- INTEREST IN THE SHRINE
- Ability to give and get cooperation
- Capable of delegating responsibility
- Understanding beforehand with wife and family

When the members of a Shrine Temple elect a Noble to any office, they are placing this Noble in the Divan Line on the assumption that he will prove qualified and worthy of advancement to the High Office of Illustrious Potentate.

Hence, it is quite evident the nominations should be based upon a thorough and accurate evaluation of character, ability, interest and experience.

ALL APPOINTMENTS BY A POTENTATE EXPIRE AT THE END OF HIS TERM

For the information of all Nobles, when a Potentate's term of office expires, all appointments made by him during his administration terminate. Appointments include, but are not limited to, the Potentate's Staff, the Appointive Divan, Ambassadors, Membership Representatives, Chairman of Committees and their members, Appointive Officers and Ceremonial Divan.

On Occasion, it is mistakenly believed, or assumed, by some Nobles, that their appointments are permanent.

This is not the case. Each Potentate, when he is installed in office as chief executive of a Temple of the Mystic Shrine, must make his own appointments including the 1st and 2nd Ceremonial Masters, Director, Marshall, Captain of the Guard, Outer Guard and Chaplain.

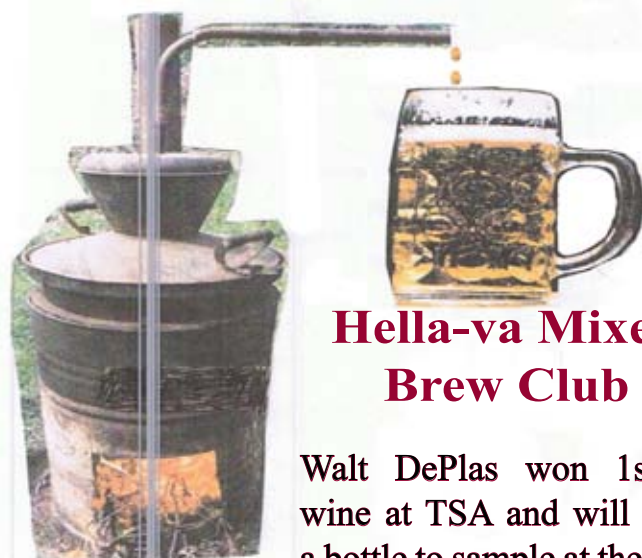
The Potentate has the power and authority under the Imperial Shrine Law to replace every appointee or he may, if he believes it to be in the best interest of the Temple, retain all appointees by re-appointment.

Traditionally many Nobles of demonstrated ability are continued in office or appointment by re-appointment. But this is at the will and pleasure of the incoming Potentate.

If a Noble is to continue in his appointive office or position, by re-appointment, he will be notified by the incoming Potentate, to that affect.

Should any Noble not holding an appointment by the current Potentate, wear a fez carrying a title bestowed upon him by a previous Potentate, the Noble wearing that fez does so in violation of the Imperial Code.

In the event a Noble is not reappointed to a position, his feelings should not be offended as there are many good Nobles that deserve an opportunity to serve Hella Temple.

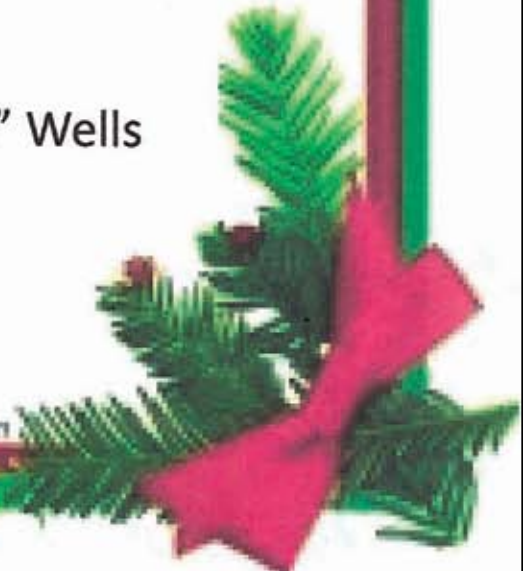

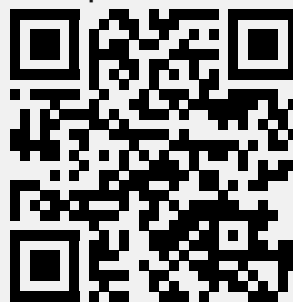

THE FIRST EAST-WEST SHRINE BOWL WAS PLAYED IN ON DECEMBER 16, 1925 IN SAN FRANCISCO. THE TOP COLLEGE FOOTBALL PLAYERS FROM THE EAST AND WEST COASTS CAME TOGETHER FOR THE VERY FIRST COLLEGE ALL-STAR GAME IN THE NATION. THE GAME RAISED \$25,000, WHICH WAS DONATED TO SHRINERS HOSPITALS FOR CHILDREN - SAN FRANCISCO.

Thirteen-year-old Chloe is a talented athlete who has plans to be a professional soccer player. While initially treated at Shriners Children's Shreveport for a broken finger sustained while practicing karate, Chloe shared with her parents she was having some shoulder pain. X-rays revealed a curve in her spine and she began physical therapy using the Schroth Method, a nonsurgical option for scoliosis treatment.

Never wasting an opportunity to develop, Chloe asked her coach if he saw any improvement in her game because of what she was doing in therapy and he told her he noticed a new explosiveness to her playing. When not on the soccer field or practicing her own karate, Chloe helps train younger students in her dojo and is preparing to start high school next school year.



At Shriners Children's Shreveport, we have a team of physicians and specialists who are highly-trained and experienced in pediatric orthopedics. This team is fully equipped to treat children with a variety of different orthopedic conditions ranging from mild to complex. Other specialties you will find at our facility include cleft lip and palate care and fracture care.

Shriners Children's model for care was imagined and established by Shriners International, the fraternal organization for which its facilities are named. Opening in September of 1922, Shriners Children's Shreveport became the first location established as part of an unprecedented health care effort.

Suggested Blue Lodge Program

Shriners International, also commonly known as The Shriners or formerly known as the Ancient Arabic Order of the Nobles of the Mystic Shrine, (AAONMS) is a Masonic society established in 1870 and is headquartered in Tampa, Florida. Shriners International describes itself as a fraternity based on fun, fellowship, and the Masonic principles of brotherly love, relief, and truth.

In The Beginning... In 1870 a group of Masons gathered frequently for lunch in New York City. Among the regulars were Walter M. Fleming, M.D. and William J. "Billy" Florence, an actor. The group frequently talked about starting a new fraternity for Masons – one centered on fun and fellowship, more than ritual. Fleming and Florence took this idea seriously enough to do something about it.

Billy Florence had been on tour in France, and had been invited to a party given by an Arabian diplomat. The exotic style, flavors and music of the Arabian-themed party inspired him to suggest this as a theme for the new fraternity. Walter Fleming, a devoted fraternity brother, built on Florence's ideas and used his knowledge of fraternal ritual to transform the Arabian theme into the Ancient Arabic Order of the Nobles of the Mystic Shrine (A.A.O.N.M.S.).

By June 1922 the cornerstone had been laid for the first Shriners Hospitals for Children® in Shreveport, La. The first patient to be admitted in 1922 was a little girl with a clubfoot, who had learned to walk on the top of her foot rather than the sole.

In 1926 the Hella Shrine Hospital for Crippled Children in Dallas, Texas, became the Scottish Rite Children's Hospital and the oversight and support was assumed by the Scottish Rite Bodies.

Never does a Shriner stand so tall as when he stoops to help a child. Through the remarkable foresight, commitment and fundraising skills of the Shriners International (Headquarters in Tampa) nearly one million children have been treated at one of the 21 Shriners Hospitals for Children across the United States, and in Canada and Mexico.

There are 196 Temples worldwide and approximately 350k members. Shriners International is a fraternity based on fun, fellowship and the Masonic principles of brotherly love, relief and truth. We strive to continue support and provide care for our Hospitals for Children with a worldwide network, no matter the families ability to pay.

Shriners International is among the greatest Philanthropy's on the planet! Shriners Hospitals for Children has 21 health systems within the United States!

Hella Hospital Fund Raisers include (not limited to):

- Bucket Drive - Annual Collection Brigades, staff designated street locations to collect money for our hospitals (Fez on the corner, branding at its best!) Usually a two-day event. Shifts are available, any time increments from 30 min to 8 hours.
- Hella Classic Dirt Track Race - Usually taking place at the Greenville Super Bowl Speedway. This event usually raises 20-30k dollars for our kids. Toys and Bicycles are drawn by tickets obtained at the box office and handed out by Nobles of the Shrine. It's always a great family activity!
- Clubs and Units around the jurisdiction of Hella will conduct annual fund raisers as well, and contribute to the Hospitals, Hospital Transportation, etc.
- We raised more than 75k dollars in 2020 through these events!

TEMPLE DUES

The nobility of each temple within Shriners International sets the amount of its annual dues to offset the administrative operations incurred by the temple.

Each member is required to remit his annual temple dues before January 1st of each year to avoid delinquency.

Look around when you attend a temple meeting or event, and you will see your temple dues hard at work. Without this financial structure, your continued membership and payment of temple dues, there would be no source from which to fund temple operations.

The future of your temple and the fraternity as a whole relies on your fidelity and faithful dues remittance!

PER CAPITA TAX

A \$50.00 Per Capita Tax shall be assessed with each member's annual dues and remitted to Shriners International in order to keep our fraternity and its Headquarters financially stable, with the continued ability to provide much-needed services.

Similarly to the way each noble's dues are necessary to maintain temple operations, each noble's Per Capita Tax payment maintains the administrative function of Shriners International.

HOSPITAL ASSESSMENT

A Hospital Assessment of \$5.00 per regular member is remitted to the Imperial Treasurer each year and deposited into the endowment fund for Shriners Hospitals for Children®.

These monies are invested to support our official philanthropy.
