## Oriental Guide

Today's younger generations, such as Millennials and Gen Z, are not engaging with fraternal organizations like the Shriners for several reasons that reflect broader societal changes.

Younger people often perceive traditional organizations like the Shriners as outdated or misaligned with their personal values. Many young adults prioritize community service and social activism, but they prefer flexible and modern approaches over hierarchical organizations. This shift indicates that young people seek "immediate impact" rather than long-term commitments tied to traditional structures.

Today's youth face numerous commitments ranging from education to work to social activities, which often leaves them with little time for involvement in organizations with regular meeting schedules and obligations. The structured time commitments required by fraternal organizations can feel burdensome compared to other forms of community involvement, such as informal volunteering or social causes.

Many fraternal organizations, including the Shriners, have been perceived as less inclusive, particularly regarding gender and racial diversity. Historically, some groups have struggled to attract members of color and women. A failure to adapt and modernize their membership policies has contributed to younger generations feeling alienated.

Younger individuals are more accustomed to "online communities" and social media-driven interactions. This shift affects their view on membership, as they may see the traditional networking and camaraderie offered by organizations

The challenges of attracting younger members to organizations like the Shriners reflect broader cultural shifts and changing values around community, inclusivity, and time commitment. Adapting to these changes may be essential for such organizations to survive and thrive in the future.

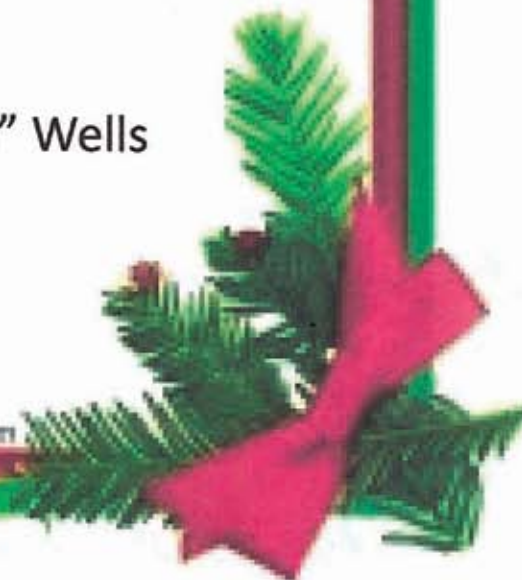

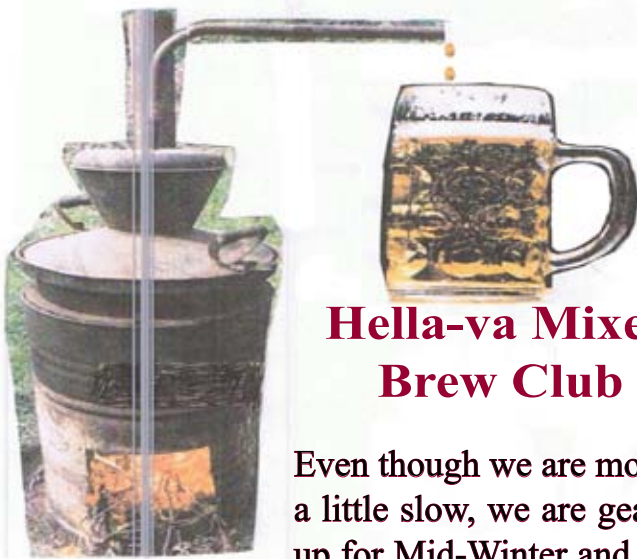

## **Alison Cernich, Ph.D.**

Named director of Shriners Children’s Research Institute

Shriners Children’s is proud to announce that Alison Cernich, Ph.D., has accepted the position of director of our Research Institute. In this role, Dr. Cernich will oversee the recruitment of researchers as well as the design and construction of the institute’s 150,000 square feet of laboratory space at the Science Square location in Atlanta, Georgia.

An experienced research leader and neuropsychologist, Dr. Cernich most recently served as acting director and deputy director of the Eunice Kennedy Shriver National Institute of Child Health and Human Development at the National Institutes of Health in Bethesda, Maryland. In that role, she helped oversee a broad research portfolio spanning child health, development, women’s health, disabilities, and rehabilitation medicine, and contributed to strategic initiatives across NIH.

“We are thrilled to welcome Dr. Cernich to Shriners Children’s at this pivotal moment in our journey,” said Chairman of the Board of Trustees Leslie D. Stewart, M.D. “As we advance Vision 2035, her leadership will help shape the future of our research enterprise, accelerating discoveries that improve care for children and families across our system.”

Dr. Cernich holds a Ph.D. in clinical psychology from Fairleigh Dickinson University, where her training focused on traumatic injury and disability-related research. She earned her bachelor’s degree in psychology from Loyola University New Orleans and is board certified in clinical neuropsychology. Her academic background spans clinical science and translational research, providing a strong foundation for research leadership.

Dr. Cernich has held senior leadership roles across major federal health and research organizations, including the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs and the U.S. Department of Defense. Across these settings, her work has focused on advancing research and innovation for children and individuals with disabilities — particularly in rehabilitation, medical devices and data-driven approaches — by bringing together clinicians, researchers, and partners to address complex, interdisciplinary challenges.

“This is an amazing opportunity to shape a research institute from the ground up,” said Dr. Cernich. “Bringing Shriners Children’s research and innovation together allows us to move discoveries from the lab into practice faster, so families see the impact through stronger outcomes and new possibilities in care.”

Originally from New Orleans, Louisiana, Dr. Cernich enjoys hiking and spending time outdoors.

“We very much look forward to Dr. Cernich leading the transformational change in research at Shriners Children’s,” said Marc Lalande, Ph.D., vice president, research programs. “Please join me in welcoming Dr. Cernich to Shriners Children’s.”

# Suggested Blue Lodge Program

Shriners International, also commonly known as The Shriners or formerly known as the Ancient Arabic Order of the Nobles of the Mystic Shrine, (AAONMS) is a Masonic society established in 1870 and is headquartered in Tampa, Florida. Shriners International describes itself as a fraternity based on fun, fellowship, and the Masonic principles of brotherly love, relief, and truth.

In The Beginning... In 1870 a group of Masons gathered frequently for lunch in New York City. Among the regulars were Walter M. Fleming, M.D. and William J. "Billy" Florence, an actor. The group frequently talked about starting a new fraternity for Masons – one centered on fun and fellowship, more than ritual. Fleming and Florence took this idea seriously enough to do something about it.

Billy Florence had been on tour in France, and had been invited to a party given by an Arabian diplomat. The exotic style, flavors and music of the Arabian-themed party inspired him to suggest this as a theme for the new fraternity. Walter Fleming, a devoted fraternity brother, built on Florence's ideas and used his knowledge of fraternal ritual to transform the Arabian theme into the Ancient Arabic Order of the Nobles of the Mystic Shrine (A.A.O.N.M.S.).

By June 1922 the cornerstone had been laid for the first Shriners Hospitals for Children® in Shreveport, La. The first patient to be admitted in 1922 was a little girl with a clubfoot, who had learned to walk on the top of her foot rather than the sole.

In 1926 the Hella Shrine Hospital for Crippled Children in Dallas, Texas, became the Scottish Rite Children's Hospital and the oversight and support was assumed by the Scottish Rite Bodies.

Never does a Shriner stand so tall as when he stoops to help a child. Through the remarkable foresight, commitment and fundraising skills of the Shriners International (Headquarters in Tampa) nearly one million children have been treated at one of the 21 Shriners Hospitals for Children across the United States, and in Canada and Mexico.

There are 196 Temples worldwide and approximately 350k members. Shriners International is a fraternity based on fun, fellowship and the Masonic principles of brotherly love, relief and truth. We strive to continue support and provide care for our Hospitals for Children with a worldwide network, no matter the families ability to pay.

Shriners International is among the greatest Philanthropy's on the planet! Shriners Hospitals for Children has 21 health systems within the United States!

Hella Hospital Fund Raisers include (not limited to):

- Bucket Drive - Annual Collection Brigades, staff designated street locations to collect money for our hospitals (Fez on the corner, branding at its best!) Usually a two-day event. Shifts are available, any time increments from 30 min to 8 hours.
- Hella Classic Dirt Track Race - Usually taking place at the Greenville Super Bowl Speedway. This event usually raises 20-30k dollars for our kids. Toys and Bicycles are drawn by tickets obtained at the box office and handed out by Nobles of the Shrine. It's always a great family activity!
- Clubs and Units around the jurisdiction of Hella will conduct annual fund raisers as well, and contribute to the Hospitals, Hospital Transportation, etc.
- We raised more than 75k dollars in 2020 through these events!
